Dear All, November 11, 2020

As discussed and suggested during the Special General Meeting, held virtually on Sunday, November 8, 2020, you are requested to comply with the following directives of the Sports Ministry/SAI and send us the following details which we need to upload on our site.

This is rather necessary and urgent as it is obligatory on TTFI to obtain the information and send them across to SAI/Sports Ministry as well.

- 1. All your affiliated districts must be registered with the proper authorities; the state association's affiliation with TTFI will depend on whether or not you have at least 50 percent of the districts affiliated to you;
- 2. How many districts are affiliated with your association currently and their names along with the details of their office-bearers' (president, secretary and treasurer) name, contact address, email, phone;
- 3. Proposed date(s) of state championships to be held this season, details of participants (category-wise) and their results:
- 4. All state units must send details of their office-bearers' (president, secretary and treasurer) name, contact address, email, phone, etc., and their age.

We had circulated some time back seeking details of state units' office-bearers and the state association's registration certificates. Not even half the number of our units has sent them so far.

Please send these details along with the age of the individuals (state office-bearers) and **DO NOT** take these things lightly. As informed during the meeting, TTFI will not only face the flak for not complying with the Sports Ministry/SAI directives (based on the Delhi High Court orders), but will also have to be prepared to face derecognition, as they did to 57 NSFs, including TTFI, very recently.
