RULES & REGULATIONS

1. ENTRY FEES

A sum of Rs.3000/- is payable to the Federation by each Association/Institution towards entry fee for team events. There is no additional entry fee for YBS U19/YGS U 19 Singles/Doubles for the players who are part of the State/Institution Team for the respective Events.

Entry fees will be charged as follows for the U 17 Junior Singles Events.

Entry fee for YBS U17/YGS U 17: Rs 900/- per player for the Singles (first four entries)

Entry fee for YBS U 17/YGS U 17 Doubles Rs 1800/- Per Pair (only two entries)

2. Events

The following events will be conducted:

- 1. U 19 Youth Boys Team Championships
- 2. U 19 Youth Girls Team Championships
- 3. U 19 Youth Boys Singles
- 4. U 19 Youth Boys' Doubles
- 5. U 19 Youth Girls Singles
- 6. U 19 Youth Girls' Doubles

- 7. U 17 Youth Boys Singles
- 8. U 17 Youth Boys Doubles
- 9. U 17 Youth Girls Singles
- 10. U 17 Youth Girls Doubles

3. System of Play:-

a) Team Events (Youth U 19)

The Team Events: U 19 Youth Boy's & Girls' Team Events will be conducted on New Swaythling Cup basis. Each team will consist of minimum 3 players and maximum of 4 players. The team events will be of best of 5 singles matches. All individual matches in the Team events will be determined by the best of 5 Games.

Order of Play shall be:

A Vs X

B Vs Y

C Vs Z

A Vs Y

B Vs X

Team events will be conducted in two stages. In the first stage all teams will be divided in groups of 3 or 4 teams and they play the league matches. Two teams from each group qualify for the second stage which will be held on a knockout basis to decide the Winners. There will be no matches for positions 3 and 4.

The Captains of the team scheduled to play at a particular time, shall report to the Referee or his appointed deputy at least 40 (Forty) minutes before the time fixed for their matches and teams not present at the time scheduled for their match are liable to concede a walk-over to their opponents.

Should a team captain not attend the toss on time, the opposing team will have the right to choose ABC or XYZ. For the team not at the toss, the referee on duty will put players in order of ranking as follows:

A or Y

1st ranked player of the team

B or X

2nd ranked player of the team

C or Z

3rd ranked player of the team

Any protest or appeal on any point of law may be made only by the Captain or, if he is absent or playing, by authorised representative of the team

Seeding for Team and Individual Events

- ➤ The seeding of the Teams will be decided on the sum total of the ranking points of the best 3 players in the team
- > Seeding for the doubles will be determined on the sum total of the ranking points of the players forming the doubles pair.
- > Nominated players and pairs of the same Association shall, as far as possible, be separated according to the following principle
- > Associations shall list their nominated players and pairs in descending order of playing strength, starting with any players included in the ranking list used for seeding, in the order of that list.
- > The entries ranked 1 and 2 shall be drawn into different halves and those ranked 3 and 4 into quarters other than those occupied by the first two.
- > Remaining entries shall be separated only in groups and in the first round of the main draw
 - b) All the singles events will be played in two stages:

The latest ranking will be followed for seeding purposes in the Singles Events

- Stage-I: All the players (except the top-eight ranked players in YBS U19, YGS U19, YBS U17, YGS U17)) will be divided into groups of 3 or 4 players in each group. They will play one another in a round-robin league format to determine the order of position in each group. All the group league matches will be of best of five games. One Player will qualify to the Second Stage.
- Stage-II: Players finishing in the first position in each group, and the top-eight ranked players in the YBS U19, YGS U19, YBS U17, and YGS U17 will play according to the single knockout system. All the Stage II matches will be of best of five games, except the following rounds which will be played in best of seven games.

Finals YBS U17, YGS U17;

Semi Final onwards in YBS U19, YGS U 19.

The schedule of play is planned as below, and may be altered, if necessary.

i) Youth Girls Events Under 17 & 19

3rd to 6th January, 2025

ii) Youth Boys Events Under 17 & 19

8th to 11th January, 2025

Girls under 17 & 19 should report on 2nd January, 2025 Boys Under 17 & 19 should report on 7th January, 2025

4. Hospitality Charges:

Each state association will pay a sum of Rs.600/- per day for each player, one manager, one coach towards hospitality Charges and the maximum people eligible for subsidized hospitality are 20, including one manager and one coach.

Hospitality will include:

- a) Accommodation at a place provided by the host association, and Boarding for Girls from Lunch on 2nd January, 2025 to Breakfast on 7th January, 2025. Boarding for Boys from Lunch 7th January, 2025 to Breakfast on 12th January, 2025
- b) Boarding shall include Breakfast, Lunch, Evening Tea and Dinner. All other charges levied will be extra and to be borne by the participants.
- 5. If the accommodation provided is far away and more than 1 Km, the hosts will make transport arrangements from Hotel to Stadium and back.
- 6. There may be three sessions of play every day.
- 7. Entitlement of entries:

Each state association can send a maximum one team each in Youth Boys U 19 Team Event, Youth Girls U 19 Team Event, Four entries each in YBS U 19, YGS U 19, YGS U 19, YGS U 19, Two entries each in YBD U 19, YGD U 19, YGD U 17, YGD U 17.

Players who are not part of the team are NOT eligible for U19/U17 Doubles and cannot be entered as Doubles pairs.

Extra Entries: State Associations are allowed to send Extra Entries in Singles Events.

The Extra Entry fee will be Rs. 4200/- per entry in Under-17 Youth Girls/Boys, while it will be Rs 6200/- per entry in Under-19. Youth Girls/Boys

TTFI can consider 32 wild card entries, if and when required.

- 8. All the events will be held under the rules & regulations of the International Table Tennis Federation and as adopted by the Table Tennis Federation of India.
- 9. ITTF/TTFI approved Equipment will be used for the Championships
- 10.. The closing date for receipt of entries online is $\mathbf{20}^{th}$ December , $\mathbf{2024}$

Open draws will be held at Venue on 2 nd January, 2025 for the Girls events and on 7 th January, 2025 for the Boys events, commencing at 10 a.m The Referee will conduct the Draw under the supervision of the Technical Committee/Competition Manager.				
Entries will be accepted only through an affiliated unit of the Table Tennis Federation of India. Direct entries from individual players will not be entertained.				
All the associations/institutions will inform the Organizing Secretary at least 10 days before the commencement of the championships the date, time and the mode of transport by which their teams will be arriving at Baroda				
Gluing and smoking is not allowed inside the hall.				
Participation certificates will be issued to all the participants of the 86 th Junior & Youth National Table Tennis Championships-2024. Those who make it to the medal rounds will get merit certificates.

OTHER INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUBMISSION OF ENTRIES

Online Entry: All entries have to be submitted online through the TTFI website portal. If new players are to be added to the data base, please key in the details and obtain the TTFI ID before entering the names in the online portal.

Youth Boys & Youth Girls Events (Under 19)

These events are open to only those players who are born on or after 01.01.2006

Junior Boys & Junior Girls Events (Under 17)

These events are open to only those players who are born on or after 01.01.2008.

Age Eligibility The respective affiliated units shall certify the correctness of the date of birth of each

entrant

Registration Form: and all players should submit their registration form (if not submitted earlier to TTFI this

year) in the prescribed format, duly attested by the Head of the Institution/School in which the player is studying and counter-signed by the respective State Association secretary. The copy of the birth certificate should also be attested by the State Secretary. In case the birth registration is not done within a year with the authorities

concerned, a court order has to be obtained.

INFORMATION FOR PLAYERS

By entering the event, players agree to abide by all TTFI rules and regulations, including that of the Organizing Committee. All associations and individual players agree to be under the auspices of the TTFI and its agents in all matters concerning television coverage, video, internet, webcasting, motion picture coverage, and photographic coverage of any kind. Participants release all rights or rights held by their agents/sponsors in all matters relating to the above. A participant's refusal to any of the above clauses may attract suspension or dismissal from the competition.
